GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

(CORPORATE)

1 SPORTS

1.1 U Games 18/19 consists of 10 sporting events.

2 ELIGIBILITY

2.1 Employees, full-time and/or contract staff, of all private, public and non-profit organizations are eligible to register for the U Games 18/19 Corporate Categories.

2.2 Employees must be from the same company / organization.

2.3 Employees must produce staff pass and/or HR authorization letter during registration on event day for verification.

2.4 Members of Associations/Clubs are not eligible to register for U Games 18/19 Corporate Package nor participate in corporate categories in any U Games 18/19 events, except U Associates registered with NTUC.

2.5 Each participant can only represent one organization and one team.

3 REGISTRATION

3.1 All registration must be done online via the U Sports e-Registration system and within the stipulated registration period.

3.2 Registration for all 10 sporting events open on 1 July 2018 and closes on the respective dates:

3.3 The team manager/captain shall register on behalf of the team.

- 3.4 Team Managers/Captain shall be the point of contact of the team and shall receive email confirmation of participation after payment is made.
- 3.5 Incomplete submissions after the registration period shall be rejected.
- 3.6 Should there be less than 6 teams in an event/category, participants may opt to join another category if they are eligible, or withdraw to receive a refund.
- 3.7 There is no limit to the number of teams each organization can register. However, each participant can only participate in one category in each sporting event unless otherwise specified.

- 3.8 Changes to participants' details will not be accepted after the closing date, unless supporting documents are provided. There will be a penalty fee of \$50 for every change in participant made after the closing date.
- 3.9 Participants in the current National Team in their respective sports are not allowed to participate in U Games 18/19 events. Teams registering these participants will be disqualified on event day immediately. Ex-national players, who had left their respective National Sports Associations (NSAs) for a period of one year, are eligible to participate in U Games 18/19 events, except for U Grand Masters Bowling whereby the lay-off period must be 3 years.
- 3.10 All participants are required to report at the Registration Counter to confirm their registration at a stipulated time (which will be stated before event day), regardless of their playing schedules. Schedules are meant as a guide only. As a match may start earlier than scheduled time, the match will be considered as a walkover if there is no-show by participant(s).
- 3.11 All participants will be required to complete the indemnity form and acknowledge the terms and conditions before the event.

4 REGISTRATION FEES

- 4.1 Payment of team registration fees will be made online via debit/credit card during registration, except for organizations that have signed up for Corporate Package. (Kindly refer to next clause for more details on Corporate Package.)

5 CORPORATE PACKAGE

- 5.1 Registration for Corporate Package is done via email to U Sports with the completed application form. Please email info@usports.com.sg for more info
- 5.2 Registration closes 31 October 2018.

- 5.3 An acknowledgement email will be sent to registrants upon successful registration of the corporate package within 3 working days. Thereafter, a special code will be provided to the registrant for subsequent event registration.
- 5.4 Payment can be made via cheque to 'NTUC Club' upon successful registration.
- 5.5 There is no limit to the number of corporate packages that each organization can purchase.
- 5.6 Package is non-transferable.
- 5.7 Top-up of credits can be made via email to U Sports. Payment of these top-up credits will be billed accordingly to the organization after the respective sporting event.
- 5.8 Balance credits are strictly non-refundable.
- 5.9 NTUC Club (U Sports) reserves the right to change the date and registration period for events.
- 5.10 NTUC Club (U Sports) shall not be liable for any loss or inconvenience caused.

6 PRIZE WINNERS

- 6.1 Prize money/vouchers and medals will be awarded to the top 4 winners of each event/category with at least 8 teams/participants. Each Champion team will also receive a Champion trophy.
- 6.2 In the event where a category proceeds with less than 6 teams, prizes will be awarded to the top 3 teams.
- 6.3 Details on prize money/vouchers shall be announced at the respective events page on U Sports official website before the close of each event registration.

- 6.4 Vouchers, if given out, will not be given a revalidation or date extension in view of the Monetary Authority of Singapore ruling.
- 6.5 Prizes not collected at event day may be collected at the U Sports office within 6 months after which the prizes will be forfeited.

7 ETHICS

- 7.1 Team Managers/Captains are responsible for the good conduct of their participants and supporters. They shall also serve as the team's representative in matters pertaining to the tournament.
- 7.2 Participants and Team Managers/Captains shall understand and abide by all the Rules and Regulations of the Tournament and abide by the decision of the Referees/Officials at all times.
- 7.3 In the case of unsportsmanlike conduct (eg. unruly behavior, abusive language, etc.) of the player/official, the Organizing Committee reserves the right to impose penalty such as disqualification and contact relevant authorities and inform the organization's management.

8 HEALTH & SAFETY

- 8.1 Participants must not be suffering from any medical condition, illness, disease, mental illness or physical / psychological impairment. Participants are not advised to participate if they are feeling unwell. In such cases, please inform the event organizer and match officials immediately.
- 8.2 Team Managers/Captains shall undertake the responsibility of ensuring the health and well-being of their team's participants.
- 8.3 Participants are encouraged to get their own Personal Accident Insurance Policy should there be any accidents/injuries suffered during the event.

9 ATTIRE

9.1 All participants must be in appropriate attire as per the safety guidelines (eg. shin guards for Futsal tournament) and sporting attire (eg. no singlet for Badminton) of each event according to the respective National Sports Associations ruling, whenever applicable. Participants not in proper attire may be subjected to disqualification.

10 PROTEST

10.1 The Organising Committee will only accept official written protest put up by the Team Manager before the end of the event.

10.2 All written official protest must be submitted with a fee of \$100 and must be made before/during the game. Protests that are made after the result has been finalised will not be accepted.

10.3 The Organising Committee will make the final decision. The protest fee shall be forfeited if the protest is found invalid.

11 BAD WEATHER

11.1 In the event of inclement or adverse weather (eg. category one lightning alert, heavy downpour or haze, etc.), the event may be suspended/cancelled at the discretion of the Organizing Committee.

11.2 Team Captains/Managers will be notified/updated via SMS on event day should there be any change of plans.

12 PRIVACY POLICY

12.1 Any photographs, motion pictures, recordings, or any other media records of this event may be used by NTUC Club for any legitimate purpose, including any commercial and marketing uses, and/ or to be uploaded onto NTUC Club's public sites and channels.

- 12.2 In the event that registered participants do not wish for his/her photographs and/ or any other media records of him/ her at this event to be used by NTUC, please inform and provide clear instructions to U Sports in writing at info@usports.com.sg.
- 12.3 All registered participants will be included into the contact list of NTUC Club, to receive regular updates on future engagement events and programmes organised by NTUC Club, as well as opportunities to contribute, share opinions and/or feedback through any of the contacts provided through any means.
- 12.4 In the event that registered participants do not wish to receive regular updates on future engagement events and programmes organized by NTUC Club, as well as opportunities to contribute, share opinions and/ or feedback, please inform and provide clear instructions to U Sports in writing at info@usports.com.sg, within 14 days of the event. U Sports will consequently be unable to inform you of subsequent engagement events.

13 OTHER MATTERS

- 13.1 Sport-specific rules and regulations will be shared separately when registration opens for the respective U Games events.
- 13.2 Captain's Briefing sessions will not be conducted. Drawing of lots (if required) for the purpose of team groupings will be conducted internally. All information (excluding fixtures) regarding the events will be sent out two weeks prior to each event via email to Team Managers/Captains.
- 13.3 Areas not covered by the above rules and regulations shall be dealt with by the Organizing Committee whose decision shall be final.
